

There will be no Holy Eucharist this Sunday and next as Father Victor continues to recover from surgery.



TRICKY TRAY 2025:

Now that we have you all thinking about baskets you can make or gift cards you can solicit or other items that you might want to contribute as "prizes" for our Tricky Tray, its time to remind you of other ways that you can help with this important event.

Stations of the Cross

Grace Church has had a long tradition of praying the Stations of the Cross during Lent. A group of us gather together at 6:30 pm each Friday during Lent to follow the path that Jesus walked from his Condemnation by Pontus Pilate to the cross on Calvary to the Tomb. It is a simple service of prayers, readings and music which allows us to walk with Jesus during his final hours. The leader and torches move around the church stopping at each of the reliefs which hang on the walls of the nave. These depict the 14 "stations" or stops on Jesus' journey.


Vestry News
