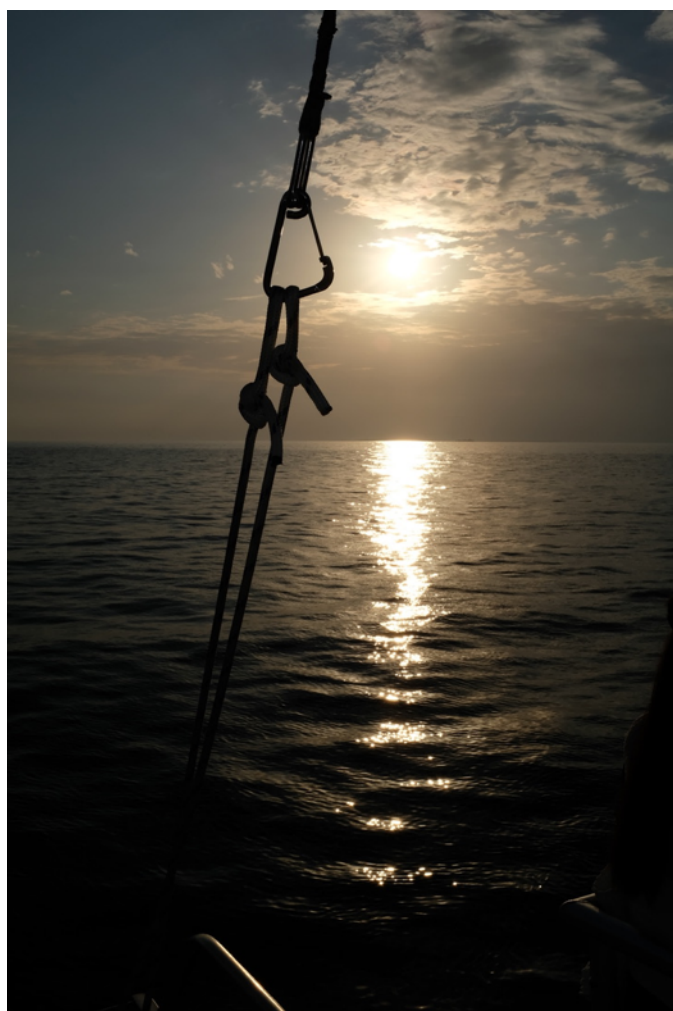

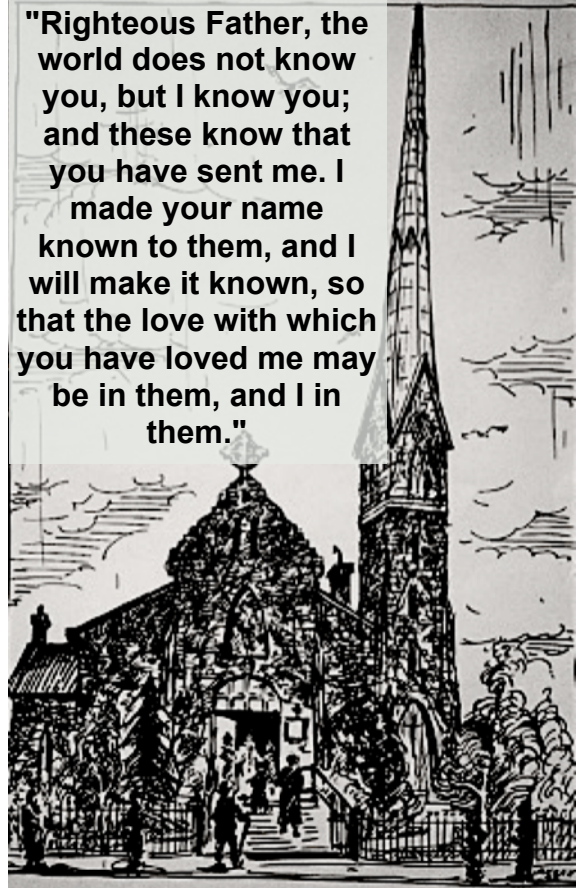
The next Vestry meeting will be held in the boardroom on Sunday June 22nd starting at 11:15 AM.
